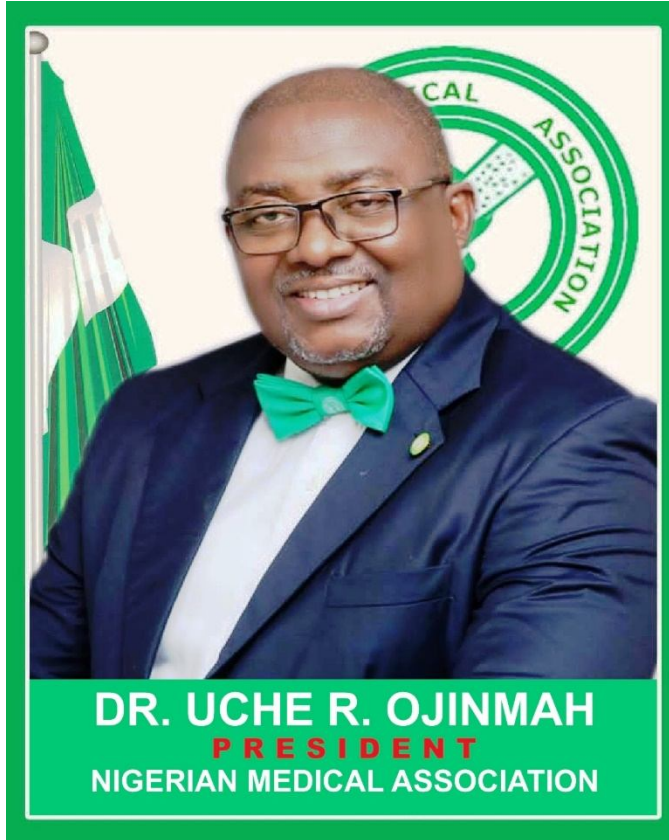


BRIEF PROFILE OF DR. UCHECHUKU ROWLAND OJINMAH



Dr. Uchechukwu Rowland Ojinmah is the current President of the Nigerian Medical Association (NMA) and Chairman of the Association of South Eastern Nigeria Dermatologists (ASEND). He is a Consultant Dermatovenereologist at the University of Nigeria Teaching Hospital and Senior Lecturer at the University of Nigeria, Enugu Campus. He has published many articles and contributed to three books.

Uche is a postgraduate examiner in the Faculty of Internal Medicine of the National Postgraduate Medical College of Nigeria and a post-graduate supervisor. He is a member of the Nigeria Association of Dermatologists (NAD), past president of the Association of Resident Doctors, UNTH and the

National Association of Residents Doctors (NARD). Uche has also served as 2nd National Vice President of the Nigerian Medical Association (NMA), Secretary of ARD-UNTH, and Chairman of the NMA national Standing Committee on Publicity and Publications. As a result of his outstanding service to the NARD, he was awarded a Life Member of the NARD in 2011. Dr. Ojinmah has also served as Chair of the NMA National Committee on the History of Medicine in Nigeria and Committee on Sports.

In 2014, he served as the LOC Chairman of the maiden NMA-Doctors' Games (EKET 2014). In 2012, he also led NMA's National ad hoc Committees to address post-election crises in Edo and Delta states, respectively. In 2013, he headed the NMA National Committee that resolved the long-standing crisis at FMC Owerri. Between 2013 and 2016, he was a member of the Management Board of the National Orthopaedic Hospital, Enugu and Chairman of the NMA National Committee on Reduction of Medical Tourism. In 2015, he was appointed to the NARD Board of Trustees (BoT), having been unanimously nominated by the NARD Southeast Caucus. A position he still holds till date. In addition, between 2016 and 2022, Dr. Ojinmah was Chair of the NMA National Sports Committee for which he received the title "Games Master General" (GMG). He has also been serving as a member of the Management Board of University of Port Harcourt Teaching Hospital since 2018.
